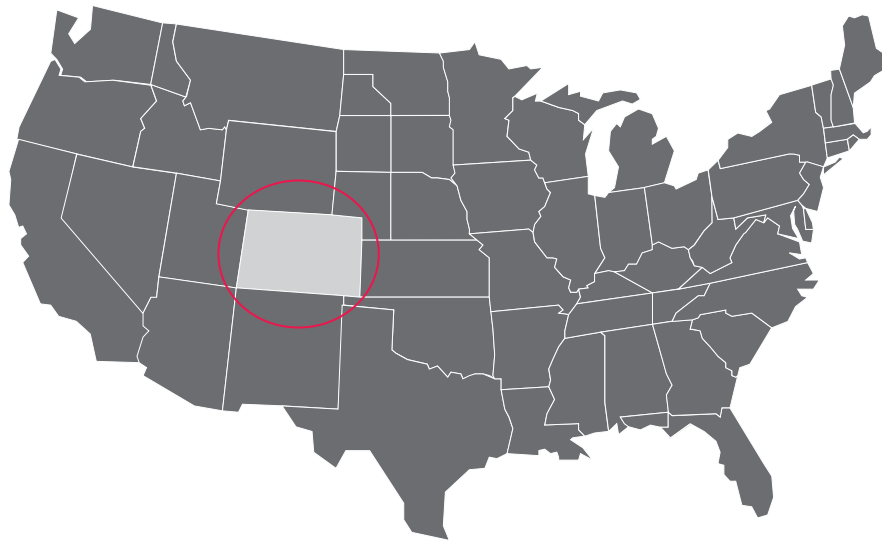

<b>STANDARD 3:</b> <b>Students write and speak using conventional grammar, usage, sentence structure, punctuation, capitalization, and spelling. In order to meet this standard, students will</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>demonstrate correct punctuation, capitalization, and spelling</li> </ul>	PP and CC: TM, SW, WB, WK PP WB practice pages: 54-86; 87-89 days of the week; months of the year CC WB practice pages:50-68; 71-74 days of the week, months of the year
In grades <b>K-4</b> , what the students know and are able to do includes	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>knowing and using correct capitalization, punctuation, and abbreviations</li> </ul>	PP and CC: TM, SW, WB, WK PP WB practice pages: 54-86; 87-89 days of the week; months of the year CC WB practice pages:50-68; 71-74 days of the week, months of the year
