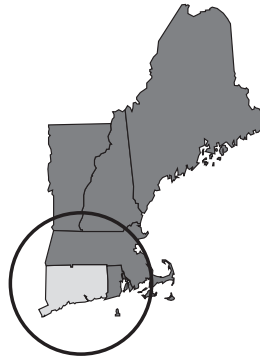

Content Standard 1: Reading and Responding
