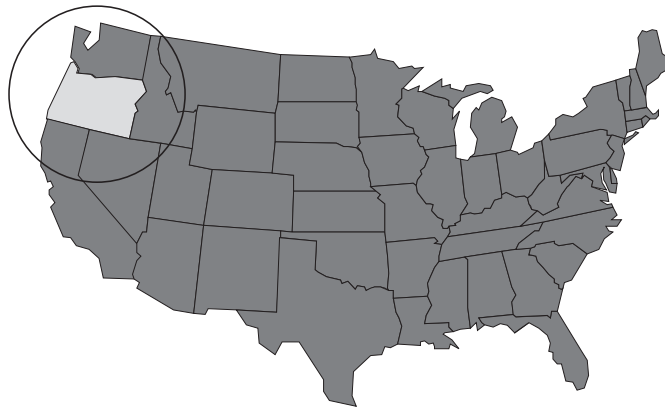

LITERATURE: Understand how literature records, reflects, and communicates, and influences human events.

Common Curriculum Goals – Read a **variety of literary forms** (e.g. novels, poems, plays, short stories, autobiographies, essays) of varying complexity from a variety of cultures and time.

Content Standards: Read a **variety of selections** and recognize distinguishing characteristics of various literary forms.

Common Curriculum Goals – Evaluate how the form of a literary work and the use of literary elements and devices (e.g., setting, plot, theme, character, word choice, point of view, tone, language) contribute to the work’s message and impact.

Analyze the development and treatment of themes in a literary work.

Content Standards: Analyze the author’s ideas, techniques, and methods and make supported interpretations of the selection.

WRITING: Use writing as a tool to learn, reflect, and communicate for a variety of audiences and purposes.

Content Standards: Use correct **grammar, spelling, punctuation, capitalization**, paragraph structure, sentence construction, and other writing conventions.
