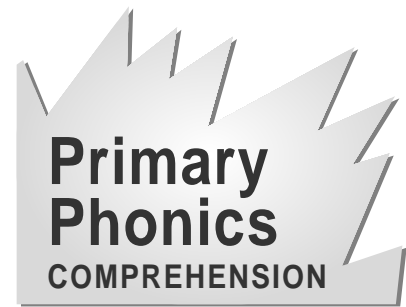


Thinking about Mac and Tab

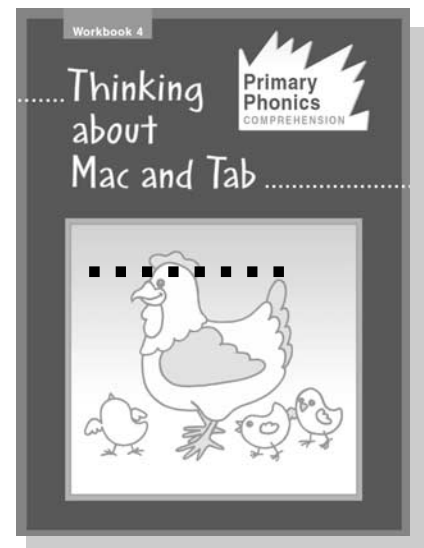

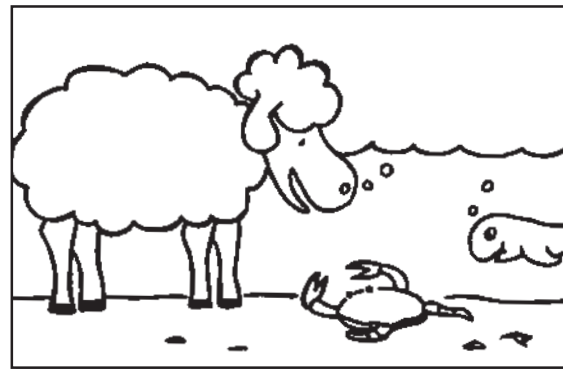
