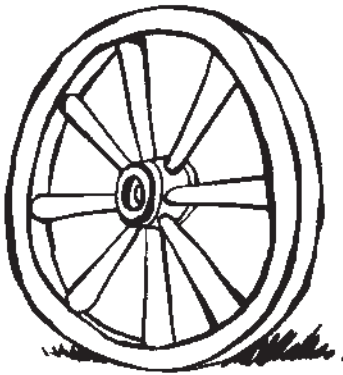
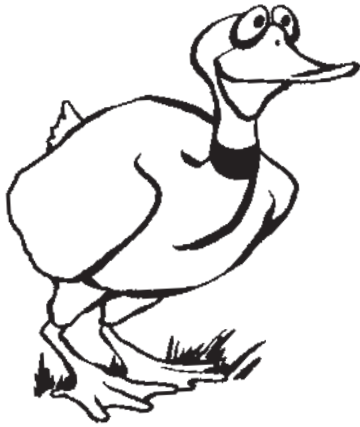
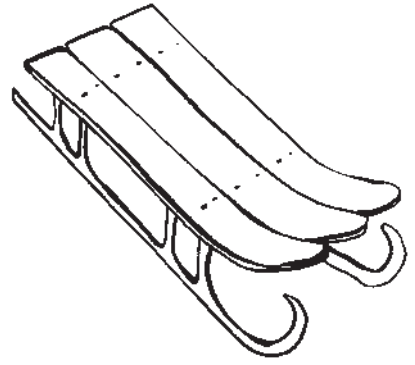
1. Name the picture cards.
2. Sort by matching rhyming pairs.



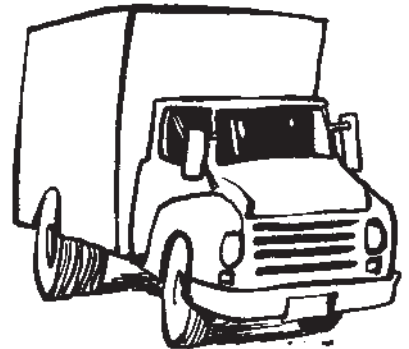
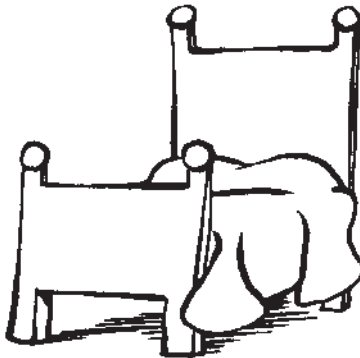
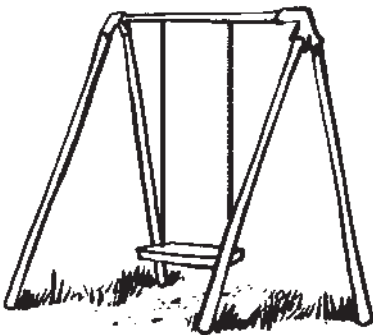
Use both words from the rhyming pair in a sentence.

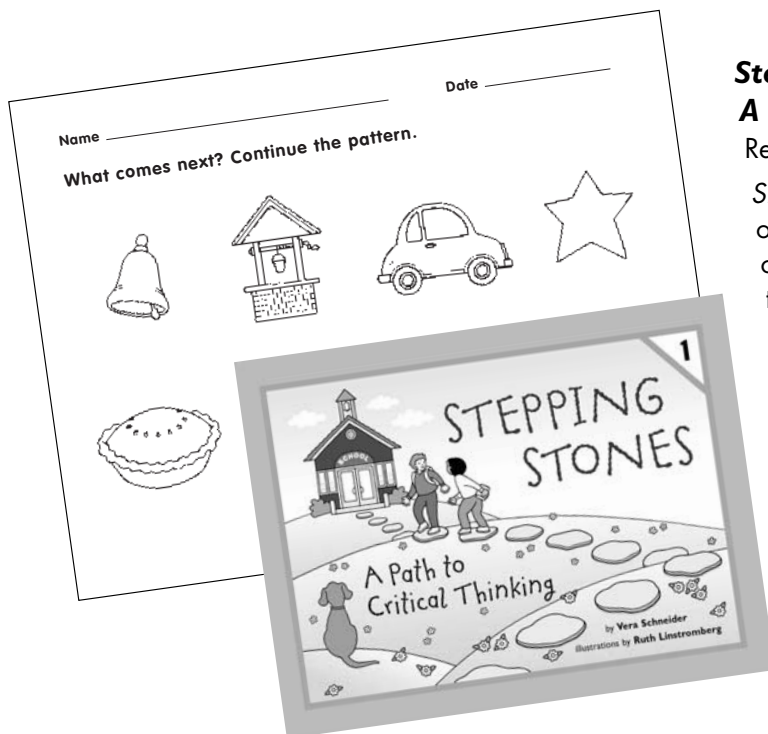
